



All timber and plasterwork to be redecorated

Reinstate lost pargetting details to panels - assume details precast off site

Double-glazed timber window with opening top lights

New slimline metal glazing with opening side casements

Alarm box reinstated on completion centered on panel

New framed and sign with hand-painted lettering and a lead flashing over.

New glazed fanlight and frame

Redecoration and basic filler repairs to 'column' top sections only

New 6 panelled door

All shop front elements redecorated - colour scheme to be agreed

Tiling replaced to steps

Existing ground floor glazing retained

Replace facing to columns / pilasters x 5 - assume 25mm thick hardwood with new battens behind

Replace stallriser panelling

Door retained but with new ironmongery
